



- Report from lain Chapple:
- The BSODR and ODRT have collaborated successfully to support and promote UK oral and dental research for many years, including aligning our brand images.
- The reason for this is that we support UK oral and dental research in complimentary ways and work together to stimulate early career and established researchers to develop competitive applications that we hope will enable them to become independent investigators, or to kick start an existing area of high potential.
- The BSODR focus on presenting and disseminating research and the ODRT focus on providing financial support for research, largely through seed corn funding initiatives, in collaboration with key industry partners.






