The forthcoming study day will be hosted in Bristol, on 6/7th February, organised by Cher Farrugia

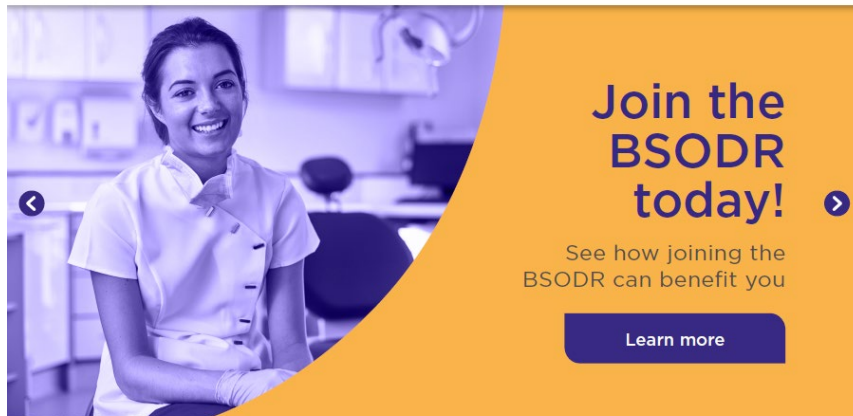
Society to engage with undergraduates. Despite best efforts, attempts to make such connections with undergraduate research societies have been futile.

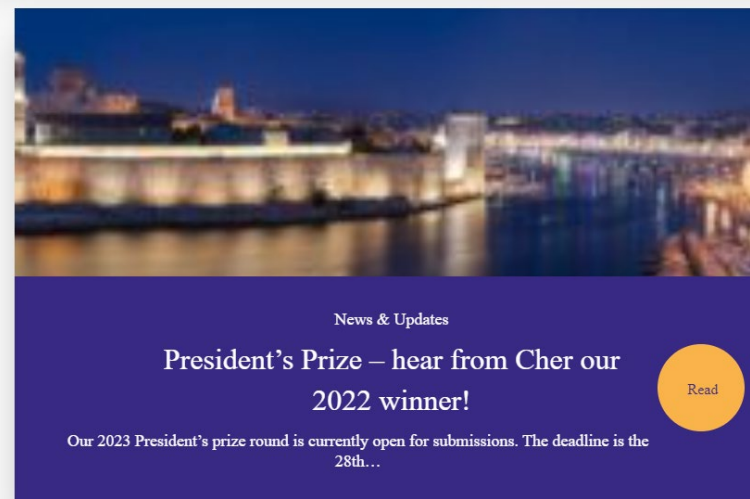
